

Cookies in detail

What are cookies?

Cookies are text files that are sent to your computer when you access a website. The website uses them to keep track of your visits and activity. The following is a list of the different types of cookies that can be used and why they are used:

- **Session cookies:** these only exist for the duration of your visit to our website and are deleted on exit. Session cookies are used to maintain the link between the web server and your computer so that you can move between various pages on our website without having to login each time. They also help maintain security
- **Persistent or permanent cookies:** these are stored on your computer's hard drive and remain there until they expire or are deleted. These cookies are used to remember the preferences or actions of the user across the website.

The above types of cookies may be set by the website you are viewing (known as first party cookies) or are set by a website other than the one you are viewing (known as third party cookies).

What cookies do we use?

- We use both first party cookies and third party cookies.
- We use cookies exclusively to help us provide a better service by monitoring which pages you find useful and which you do not.

The Cookies table on the next page explains the types of individual cookies that we currently use, their purpose and how you can opt out or reject these cookies.
